Tax refund option for Petrol users

WHAT IS EXCISE DUTY?

Excise duty is a tax imposed by the government on certain items including petrol. From the 1 July 2013 the payment increased by 3 cents per litre (the first of 3 rises planned over the next 3 years) bringing the total payment on excise tax to 63.424 cents per litre before GST.

However in some cases the NZ Transport Agency can offer refunds on excise tax on exempt vehicles.



WHAT IS AN EXEMPT VEHICLE?

In general agricultural vehicles, some mobile machinery and commercial vehicles that use petrol and don't travel on the road are classed as exempt vehicles.



HOW DO I CLAIM MY REFUND?

We can provide you with a quarterly report that can be either given to your accountant or you can personally complete and submit an MR70 form to The Excise Duty Officer (through the NZ Transport Agency Crown Revenue department) to claim your refund.

The MR70 Forms can be found on our website under Information & Downloads.

Excise tax is claimed on a quarterly basis, however you can backdate this rebate for the past two years, please note a 10% penalty fee for backdated claims applies.



BENEFIT TO YOU?

If your property receives 4000L of petrol every year you could be entitled to a rebate of \$2916.

It is your choice to apply but remember you are entitled to this refund.
